

# Zoom User Account and Limits.

## Basic Account:

- Is a **free account** with 40 minutes' limit on group meetings. Users can Host a meeting with up to 100 participants (100 individual connections) which will automatically disconnect in **40 minutes**.
- Unlimited 1 to 1 meetings. Host connects with only 1 Participant (has only 1 connection to his/her meeting) and will have unlimited meeting minutes.

### Tip:

**Schedule or Setup a Recurring meeting with Free account so that you can use the same meeting link to re-connect your meeting/live lecture after it disconnects in 40 mins.**

- A Basic (free) account is sufficient to Host a meeting and record the session (lecture recording scenario)

## On-Premise account, previously known as Corporate account:

- It is a paid user account which allows a host to connect to 300 participants (300 individual connections to his/her meeting) with unlimited meeting minutes.
- Regardless of the account type, a user can only host 1 meeting at a time.
