

## EXPLAIN THE SCIENCE -3 | In the iTaukei Language A Panel Discussion and Q&A on the COVID-19 Vaccine in Fiji

As Fiji battles the second wave of the COVID-19 infection, the Ministry of Health and Medical Services has also strengthened its efforts in the roll-out of the Astrazeneca (AZ) vaccination programme across the country.
