This can be done via online enrolment or you can email your enrolment forms to the Office of Registrar. Please note **Semester 2 2021 Enrolment is open** from 5<sup>th</sup> July 2021 to 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2021.

# Either of the following options can be utilized for Semester 2 Enrolment:

### **Option 1**

Please follow correct programme structure while enrolling into courses. Invoice for Semester 2, 2021 will be forwarded on student email addresses and payment of **non-refundable enrolment fees**, **tuition fees** or any **other fees** can be done by direct deposit into BSP bank either via electronic transfer or using the deposit slip available in banks or deposit slip attached to invoice. Students can also pay their fees through Vodafone M-PAISA. Students can email their deposit slip on <a href="RevenueQueries@fnu.ac.fj">RevenueQueries@fnu.ac.fj</a>. Once the payment will be updated, the updated invoice and receipt will be sent via email. Payment plan option is

available to students enrolled in Semester 1, 2021 and facing financial difficulties.
