## **Graduation Gowns**

Graduands can hire the gowns from certificate collection venues. The gown hire details, and hire/purchase form is available on the graduation page.

Students entering campus to collect their certificates are to take note of the entry requirements below;

- Only students who have been fully vaccinated (or who have proof that they have been granted exemption from vaccination) will be permitted to enter FNU premises.
- Students will be required to show proof of vaccination status and their FNU identification card to security at the campus entrance. Failure to show both documents will result in refusal of entry.
